## Facilities Master Planning History

#### May 2023 Bond Issue

- New Grades 6-8 Middle School
- New Pre-K-2 Elementary School

#### Cost

- \$102,086,000
- 6.7 mils
- \$235 annually

Eligible for 33% OFCC reimbursement



- New Middle School Athletic Facility






## New 6-8 Middle School: Proposed Floor Plan



- 9-12 High School
- 6-8 New Middle School
- 3-5 Intermediate School at Edgewood
- Pre-K-2 at Kean, Parkview, and Melrose





# Where We Are Going



## Bond Issue: May 6, 2025

Total Cost: \$67,000,000

OFCC Cofunding: estimated \$9 million

Bond Millage: 3.4 mils

Cost per \$100,000 of property valuation: \$119 annually or \$9.92 monthly

## **Future of Cornerstone**

- Approach Wooster Growth about acquiring the property
- Collaborate with the City/Wooster Growth to evaluate RFP options
  - Proposals will evaluate the appropriateness of preservation
  - End Goal: Combination of Housing, Community Use Facility, and PlayLab/Greenspace
- Littlest Generals Preschool will be relocated to Parkview or Kean

Conceptual design based on the City's Master Plan.


## Redistricting Plan

#### **Address Population Redistribution**

- 700+ Planned Housing Units
  - Majority on North End

Redistricting will evenly distribute grades K-2 at Kean, Melrose, and Parkview by revising geographic boundaries.

 Redistricting will occur regardless of the outcome of the bond.



## Redistricting Timeline

If levy passes: Redistricting will occur when new middle school opens (Est. Fall 2028)

• Boundaries will be adjusted to equitably fit K-2 students in Parkview, Melrose, and Kean

#### If we build a new middle school:

- Littlest Generals Preschool will be moved to Parkview or Kean
- All students grades 3-5 will attend Edgewood Intermediate School
- All students grades 6-8 will attend New Middle School
- All students grades 9-12 will attend Wooster High School



## Redistricting Timeline

If levy fails: Redistricting will occur for the 2026-2027 School Year

- Boundaries will be adjusted to evenly distribute K-2 students at Parkview, Melrose, and Kean
- Grades 3 and 4 at Cornerstone

#### If we do not build a new middle school:

- Littlest Generals Preschool will remain at Cornerstone or be moved to Parkview or Kean
- All students grades 3-4 will attend Cornerstone
- All students grades 5-7 will remain at Edgewood
- All students grades 8-12 will remain at Wooster High School
